

Safety on your Taupo SPCA Visit

To ensure everyone enjoys their visit to Taupo SPCA Animal centre, we ask that your organization is aware of the following safety and behaviour expectations:

For your visit to us:

Please confirm booking with SPCA and ensure bus driver knows where to go (please refer to the map on the website Contact Us page).

Please report to reception on arrival.

Children must have adequate footwear. **NO BARE FEET OR JANDELS!**

Please bring a \$2.00 donation per child; a donation receipt will be provided by us for your organisation. This donation helps us continue to provide SPCA education services to the Taupo region.

For visits involving children/young persons, please ensure you bring adequate adult supervisors as behaviour management is not the responsibility of Animal Centre staff.

Any child requiring a toilet stop will need to be supervised by an adult from your group.

No running - please walk around all parts of the centre.

No tapping, banging or poking fingers through animal cages.

No shouting at animals (or each other).

No teasing, including mimicking animals.

No entering of cages or fenced areas - please stay behind barriers and out of isolation areas at all times.

No feeding - our animals have special diets and 'people food' can make them ill.

No balls, hacky sacks or frisbees please.
